

## Ḥadīth Twenty Five

# The last two verses of Sūrah al-Baqarah is powerful against the shayāṭīn

The Messenger has believed in what was revealed to him from his Lord, and [so have] the believers. All of them have believed in Allāh and His angels and His books and His messengers, [saying]: We make no distinction between any of His messengers. And they say: We hear and we obey. [We seek] Your forgiveness, our Lord, and to You is the [final] destination.

Allāh does not charge a soul except [with that within] its capacity. It will have [the consequence of] what [good] it has gained, and it will bear [the consequence of] what [evil] it has earned. "Our Lord, do not impose blame upon us if we have forgotten or erred. Our Lord, and lay not upon us a burden like that which You laid upon those before us. Our Lord, and burden us not with that which we have no ability to bear. And pardon us; and forgive us; and have mercy upon us. You are our protector, so give us victory over the disbelieving people (2:285-286)."

He who recites the two verses at the end of Sūrah Al-Baqarah at night, they will suffice him.

Allāh wrote in a book two thousand years before He created the heavens and the earth, and He sent down two verses from it to end Sūrah al-Baqarah with. If they are recited for three nights in a home, no devil shall come near it.

Recorded in Al-Tirmidhī; Ṣaḥīḥ.

إِنَّ اللَّهَ كَتَبَ كِتَابًا قَبْلَ أَنْ يَخْلُقَ السَّمَوَاتِ وَالْأَرْضَ بِأَلْفَيْ  
عَامٍ أَنْزَلَ مِنْهُ آيَتَيْنِ خَتَمَ بِهِمَا سُورَةَ الْبَقَرَةِ وَلَا يُقْرَأُ فِي  
دَارٍ ثَلَاثَ لَيَالٍ فَيَقْرُبُهَا شَيْطَانٌ

### Points of benefit:

1. These two verses are enough to protect oneself from all harms.

2. The shayāṭīn cannot stay in a house where these two verses are recited three days consecutively.
3. These two verses block and protect the house from the shayāṭīn, even preventing them from coming near it.
