Flee and seek refuge with the Power of Allāh

Indeed, We will support Our messengers and those who believe during the life of this world and on the Day when the witnesses will stand (40:51).

إِنَّا لَنَنْصُرُ رُسُلَنَا وَالَّذِينَ آمَنُوا فِي الْحَيَاةِ الدُّنْيَا وَيَوْمَ يَقُومُ
الْأَشْهَادُ ﴿٥١﴾

He who recites three times every morning and evening: With the Name of Allāh with Whose Name there is protection against every kind of harm in the earth or in the heaven, and He is the All-Hearing and All- Knowing - nothing will harm him.

مَا مِنْ عَبْدٍ يَقُولُ فِي صَبَاحِ كُلِّ يَوْمٍ وَمَسَاءِ كُلِّ لَيْلَةٍ : بِاسْمِ
اللَّهِ الَّذِي لَا يَضُرُّ مَعَ اسْمِهِ شَيْءٌ فِي الْأَرْضِ وَلَا فِي السَّمَاءِ
وَهُوَ السَّمِيعُ الْعَلِيمُ ، ثَلَاثَ مَرَّاتٍ إِلَّا لَمْ يَضُرَّهُ شَيْءٌ

Recorded in Aḥmad; Ṣaḥīḥ.

Points of benefit:

1. The power of this duā is directly connected between a worshipper and his protector.
2. Allāh fully knows and is completely aware of what you are going through and the pain you are experiencing because of the siḥr, evil eye and shayāṭīn.
3. This duā, if repeated whilst blowing or wiping, during ruqyah treatment no sāḥir (magician) or shaiṭān can withstand it.
