

## Ḥadīth Forty Two

# The saliva of some of our upright Rāqīs and noble Muslims can be a means of cure

The Prophet (ﷺ) used to say to the patient, "In the Name of Allāh The earth of our land and the saliva of some of us cure our patient."

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Recorded in Al-Bukhārī & Muslim.

Imam Al-Nawawī said: The Prophet would take his own saliva with his index finger, then insert into the earth ensuring some of the soil remains on his finger and then rub it against the painful area or wound reciting the aforementioned words.

وصفة ذلك كما قال الإمام النووي رحمه الله : أنه أخذ من ريق نفسه على إصبعه السبابة ، ثم وضعها على التراب فعلق به شيء منه ، ثم مسح به الموضع العليل أو الجريح قائلاً الكلام المذكور في حالة المسح

### Points of benefit:

1. The Messenger of Allāh (ﷺ) used to do this often to his unwell companions.
2. Again, the mention of Allāh's Name is key to the treatment and cure.
3. The saliva of some of the upright Rāqīs and pious noble men and women can be a means of cure.
4. The Name(s) of Allāh when mentioned with pure soil mixed with upright Muslim saliva and placed on an injury or pain or on an ill person can be a means of cure for them whilst repeating this duā.
